# **Public Announcement**

**Holiday Lights on the River at Saluda Shoals Park** will be held each night, November 25 through December 31 from 6:00 to 10:00 p.m. As in the past, the success of this event will affect traffic on Bush River Road.

The Irmo Chapin Recreation Commission and the Lexington County Sheriff's Department have developed a plan to help alleviate traffic congestion as much as possible. The plan includes the following:

- On December 4, 5, 11 and 12<sup>th</sup> Police officers will be assigned to direct traffic at the entrance to Saluda Shoals Park.
- An additional officer will be assigned to work Wescott Road December 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> and December 17<sup>th</sup> through 23<sup>rd</sup> (during the Nights of Wonder)
- An electronic sign will be located at the intersection of St. Andrews Road and Bush River Road informing motorists of the event and traffic delays.
- On heavy traffic nights (as determined by ICRC staff and Lexington County Sheriff's Department) cars will only be allowed to turn right when leaving Saluda Shoals Park
- It is recommended that residents in neighborhoods between Saluda Shoals Park and St. Andrews Road exit going towards St. Andrews Road if possible.

It is our goal to manage traffic safely and efficiently for people in the community who celebrate the holidays with us, while minimizing the impact on our neighbors.
